Fuel Level Sender Guard Installation

- 1. Set the parking brakes and chock the tires.




Fig. 1, Fuel Level Sender Guard Installation

- 2. Remove two of the five fuel level sender mounting screws. Make sure that the two screws removed are horizontally aligned, and will allow for the lip of the guard to be oriented away from the vehicle. See Fig. 1.
