Repairing Antenna Mounts on Cascadia Vehicles

General Information

Antenna mounting studs are breaking on some Cascadia vehicles built prior to April 5, 2010. If this occurs, replace the broken mounting stud rather than replacing the entire mounting bracket. Use the instructions in this bulletin to replace the mounting stud.

Work Instructions

- 1. Shut down the engine and chock the tires.




Fig. 1, Antenna Assembly

- 2. Remove the antenna and the cover from the antenna mounting bracket. See Fig. 1.

- 3. Remove the mounting bracket.
 - 3.1 Remove the three screws securing the bracket to the cab wall.
 - 3.2 Remove the antenna mounting stud from the bracket.




Fig. 2, Antenna Mounting Stud Currently Installed on the Vehicle

 - 3.3 Disconnect the antenna cable from the stud. See Fig. 2.
- Connect the new antenna mounting stud to the antenna cable PL-259 connector and tighten securely. See
 Fig. 3.
- 5. Attach the antenna mounting stud to the mounting bracket.

NOTE: When installing the insulator to the antenna assembly, make sure that the ridge is facing down into the bracket.

- Install the insulator, the star washer, and the mounting nut from kit 22-52491-000 on the bracket. See Fig.
 4.
- 7. Install the mounting bracket on the vehicle.
 - 7.1 Position the bracket on the cab wall, and install the three mounting screws.
 - 7.2 Tighten the screws 10 lbf-ft (13 N·m).
- 8. Install the cover and antenna mast.




Fig. 3, New Antenna Mounting Stud




Fig. 4, Antenna Mounting Stud Kit

Use the kit 22-52491-000 to repair a broken antenna mounting stud. Two kits are necessary if antenna repair is required on the driver and passenger side of the vehicle.
