


Removal

Apply the parking brake and place the shift lever in neutral.



Remove all cables from ground (negative) battery terminals to prevent personal injury from electrical shock.




Cut all tie straps securing harness connector or sensor lead.





Installation




Apply a high temperature anti-seize compound to the threads of replacement sensor. Install sensor into outlet module. Tighten the sensor to specification.

Note: For torque specification, refer to the specification bulletin in group 20.







Install control module fasteners. Tighten fasteners to specification.



Connect harness to control module.






4 Secure harness and sensor lead with tie straps.
